The area is a far more logical and indeed sustainable area to accommodate growth within Christchurch and represents consolidation rather than peripheral growth. 4. The land can be easily integrated with the existing surrounding urban area. 5. The location better meets the objectives and policies of Plan Change 1 to the Regional Policy Statement, in particular Objectives 1, 3, 4, 7 and 8 and Policies 1, 7, 8 and 10 6. Urban growth in this area would better meet the purpose of the Resource Management Act in term of sustainable management of resources.
